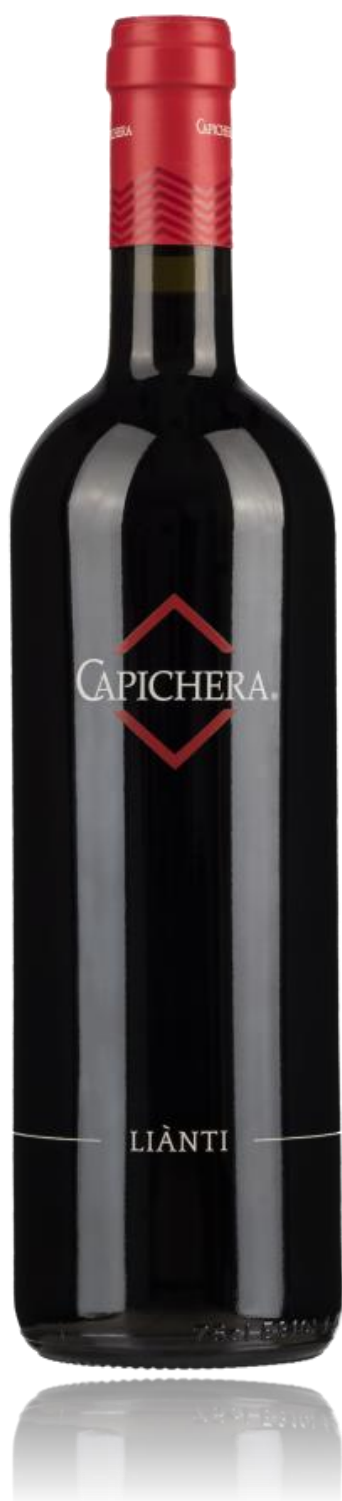


Liànti Isola dei Nuraghi IGT



Its name in the Gallura dialect indicates the East, the cardinal point on the horizon where the sun rises.

Grape Variety Carignano

Vineyards Gallura and Sulcis. Capichera vineyards in the municipalities of Olbia and Palau.

Vine Age 5-10 years

Exposure & Altitude
South East - East, 20-120m above sea level.

Soil Sandy, clay-rich and chalky

Vine Training Alberello, Espalier and Guyot. 5000 plants per hectare.

Yield 7.7 - 8 tonnes per hectare

First vintage 2009

Sensory Profile Ruby red with garnet reflections. The aroma is complex and intense with hints of spice and cinnamon, rhubarb, black fruit jelly and mocha. The taste is enveloping and elegant with sweet notes of mature fruits and fine tannins. Balanced and pleasant.

Ageing Potential 3-4 years after release.

Serving Temperature 16-18 °C.
