STYLE *crisp and fresh*, *fruit driven with a savoury edge*

AROMA lifted musk with hints of strawberries and cream

PALATE vibrant zesty red fruits with persistent musk tones ending with a crunch of vibrant acidity and savoury undertones

DRINK now

FOOD a small victory would be pairing this Rosé with lobster rolls for a decadent afternoon snack

VINEYARD Elderton vineyard, Greenock, Barossa Valley

SOIL lean soils of red and brown clay mixed with some lighter sandy loams

SEASON perfectly slow and steady describes the 2021 vintage. Frustratingly the Grenache yield was very low due to a combination of heat and wind at flowering. Netting helped keep the birds away from the Mataro, which forms the backbone of this wine.

WINEMAKING the Mataro and Grenache were hand picked and then crushed straight to press. Racking post cold settling incorporated some light lees to give a little texture to the finished wines structure.
