- ALC/VOL 14.0%

- TA 5.7 G/L

WINEMAKING

- Fruit sourced from Yarra Valley floor vineyards
- Crushed and de-stemmed into open fermenters. Pumped over twice daily
- 8 days on skins, inoculated with FX10 for elegance and structure
- 12 months in seasoned french hogs heads before bottle
