Tasting notes

TASTING NOTES TO COME WHEN I GET THE DIVINE INSPIRATION TO WRITE THEM which usually requires considerable consumption of this wine! HOWEVER I can tell you a couple of things about this wine, it was picked on the 7/4/10 Feast Day of St John Baptist de la Salle Patron Saint of Educators. He dedicated his life to the education of poor children in France. It comes from my Limerick Vineyard, part of which is planted with 2 acres of Shiraz in the Armagh Valley of the Clare Valley. It is dry grown and likes to linger on the vine in the heat to gain maximum flavour, thus the late date of picking. Only 450 cases produced and as I have no 2011 there will not be another until the 2012 is released in 2014. This wine is prayerdynamically produced.
